Objectives

- Review and maintain the five OMB-recommended PMSC guides to reflect
 - Changes to ANSI/EIA 748, policies, and regulations
 - Lessons learned and advancements in best practices for integrated program management
- Also includes the Planning & Scheduling Excellence Guide (PASEG) inherited from the NDIA ICPM
- Place all guides on a 3-year mandatory review/update cycle from the date of publication of each revision
- Guides Update Steering Group
 - To advise the PMSC Board of changes in policy and regulation that should be immediately incorporated in one or more guides
 - To accept requests for out-of-cycle changes and determine:
 - If change is appropriate and warranted
 - If change is immediately required
 - If change should be held for next regular update
