

On the one hand


- Defence budgets under pressure

Skills planning – an example of the challenges to be faced






Significant reduction in Engineering resource requirement between programmes

Some External Influencing Factors?

- Global forecast relatively flat or dropping
 - ~8% drop in global shipbuilding market
 - <u>But</u> Specific markets growing strongly
 - e.g. Brazil naval market, significant growth over next 10 years
 - 30% growth in SE Asian submarine market out to 2020
- Geopolitics will continue to drive interest in capability
 - Growth in offshore energy and oceanic resources
 - Dispute of territorial limits
- Technology
 - Advancement in commercially available technology
 - Development of autonomous systems
