Strategic Goals


- Through partnership and collaboration to:

- Leverage the best of HSI best practices and technology use from government, industry and academia to close gap areas and position HSI for the future


Improved Total System Performance



Meeting with Chris Fletcher, NDIA Procurement Division and Director, Executive Branch Policy, NDIA (4/29/15)



- Purpose: Try and get alignment and stakeholder buy-in for early acquisition, and ensure HSI is captured properly.
- Background:
 - Historically, the acquisition agency has generally not been fully integrated with Request for Proposal (RFP) writers and proposal reviewers with respect to HSI.
 - Creates a problem with a company that receives an RFP in that they have very little power to force, from the grass roots level, a fully integrated HSI approach.

Meeting with Chris Fletcher, NDIA Procurement Division and Director, Executive Branch Policy, NDIA (4/29/15)



- Background (continued):
 - Acquisition includes great words for integration of HSI (e.g., DoDD 5000.01 and DoDI 5000.02),
 - 1. RFP writers seem to water that down with wording that reflects a confusion between HSI and Human Factors/Ergonomics (HFE)
 - 2. Hurts HSI people specifically in the ranks in planning, scheduling, and writing into the proposal a fully integrated HSI effort.
- Industry ends up with HSI deliverables that often reflect only the HFE effort, not the integration of the seven HSI domains: (HFE, Safety, Training, Personnel, Manpower, Habitability and Survivability).

Action Items



- Chris to send HSI Committee a copy of NDIA's <u>Pathway</u> to <u>Transformation Acquisition Report</u>.
- Chris to add HSI Committee to the NDIA Procurement Division distribution list.
 - Will continue to communicate with Procurement Division and explore opportunities to be used as a cross service for initiatives if needed.

HSI Committee Meeting with David Schulte New HSI rep to OSD (4/30/15)



- Purpose: Reach out to HSI representative at the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) and discuss plans on how the NDIA SE HSI Committee plans to reenergize its base.
 - Turnover in HSI Committee
 - Turnover at OSD

HSI Committee Meeting with David Schulte New HSI rep to OSD (4/30/15)



- Resume HSI Committee meetings
 - Target is to meet every quarter
 - Use meetings to mark progress, document challenges
 - Target time for first meeting: Early June, 2015
 - Dave Schulte to reach out to gov't SE team
- Explore other opportunities:
 - Matt Risser to meet with OSD System of Systems (SoS) collaborators info exchange this October
 - Work with NDIA Human Systems Division to take HSI success stories to Congress
 - HSI Committee should be involved in creating a common approach, and a common format of the success stories.

HSI Committee Meeting with David Schulte New HSI rep to OSD (4/30/15)



- Explore other opportunities (continued):
 - Reach out to Environmental Safety and Occupational Health (ESOH) Committee to see if there is an interest in conducting a joint HSI/ESOH conference track
 - Participate in more SE Division bimonthly meetings (at least two per year).

HSI Committee Meeting with Sherman Forbes, Chair of NDIA SE ESOH Committee (05/15/15)



- ESOH/HSI track under discussion
 - Matt took the action to send out emails encouraging HSI personnel to submit abstracts for the SE Division conference
- Agreed to take a "wait and see" approach
 - Discussions will continue depending on how many HSI abstracts are received
 - If 4 or more abstracts are received, will have an HSI track
 - If 3 or less are received, will consider ESOH/HSI track
 - Emphasize the extension of deadline to encourage more abstract submissions.
