# Definitions



## Joint:

- **A: Activities, operations, organizations, etc., in which elements of two or more Military Departments participate. (Joint Pub 1-02)**
- **B: Integrated employment of air, land, and maritime capabilities. (circa 1947)**

## Command and control:

- **Exercise of authority and direction by a properly designated commander over assigned and attached forces in the accomplishment of the mission. ...performed through an arrangement of personnel, equipment, communications, facilities, and procedures employed by a commander in planning, directing, coordinating, and controlling forces and operations in the accomplishment of the mission. (Joint Pub 1-02) *Fundamentally a human endeavor ....***

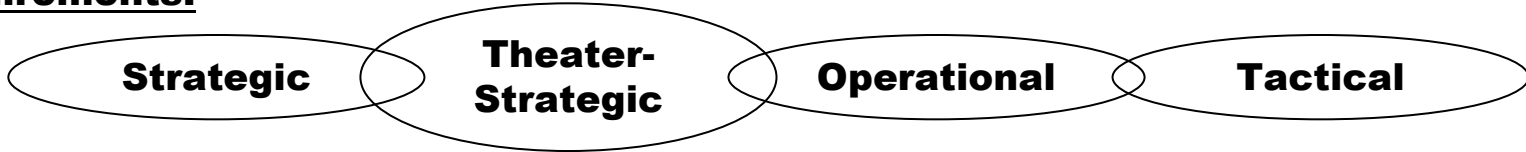
- **Ability to execute a specified course of action (Joint Pub 1-02)**



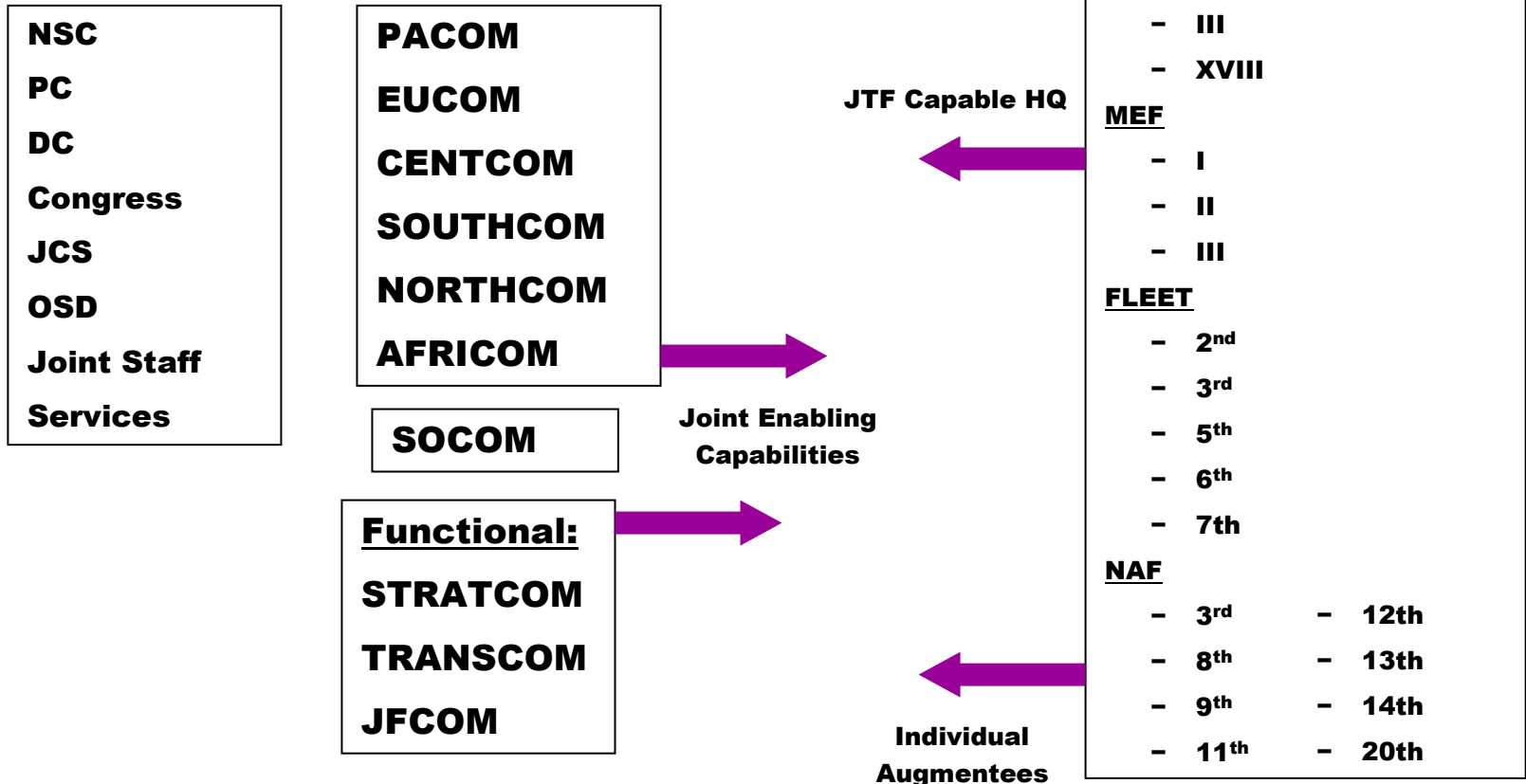

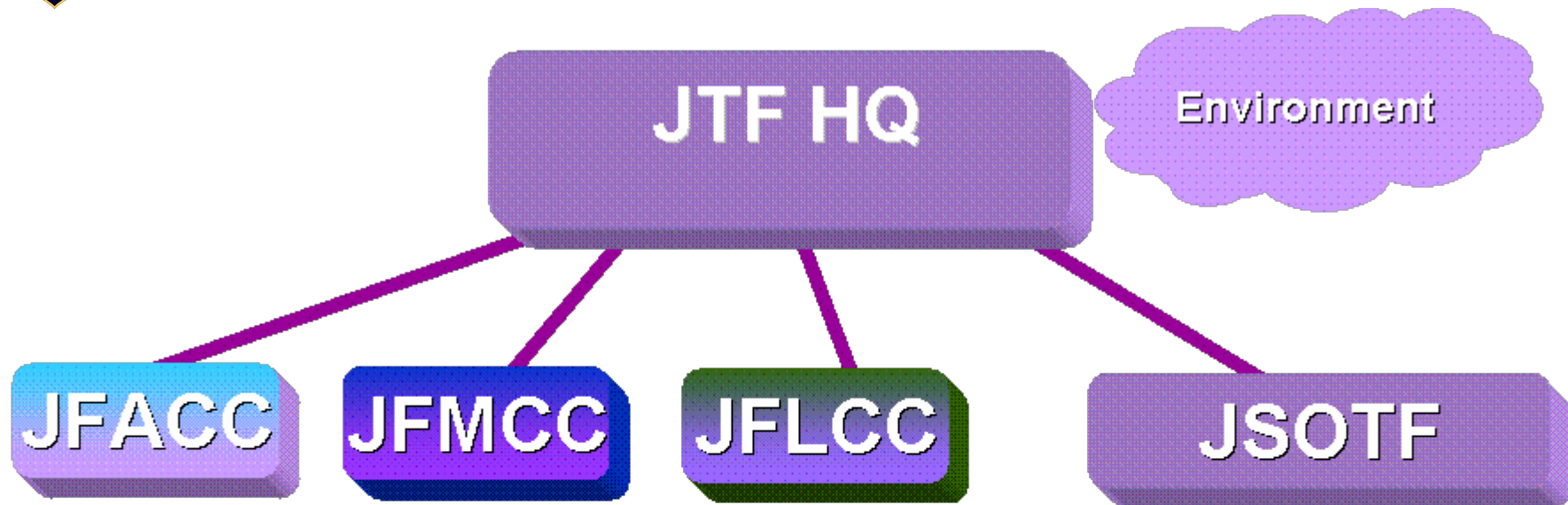

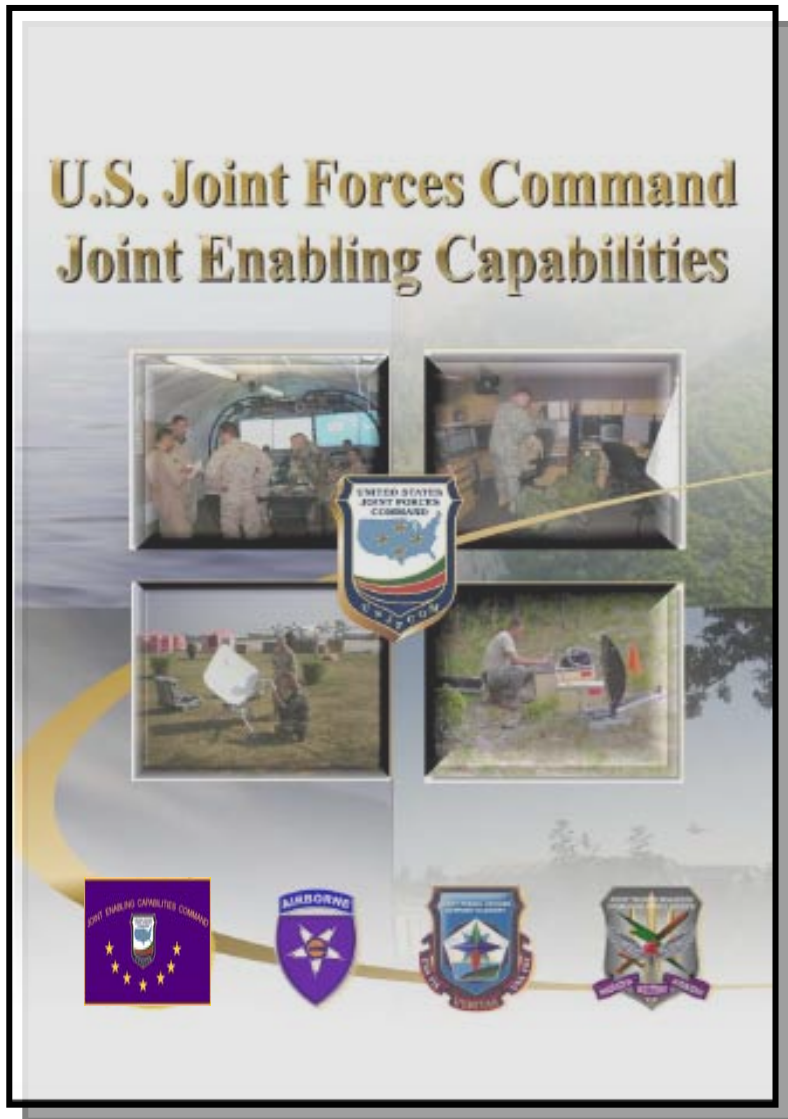

# Joint Deployable Teams (JDT)



- Task organized to meet mission requirements
- Composed of trained and ready joint Operations, Plans, Information Superiority/Knowledge Management and Logistics expertise
- The teams enable the joint task force headquarters to:
  - Rapidly form with trained and skilled teams
  - Plan and execute with skill and speed
  - Integrate with non-military elements of national power for crisis resolution

# Joint Communications Support Element (JCSE)

## Capabilities

- Expeditionary – Deploy in less than 18 hours
- Early entry for 40 seat Joint Command and Control node
- Commercially air transportable
- Seamlessly scales from an early entry package to a full Joint Task Force (JTF)
- Access to full range of DoD & commercial networks

# Joint Public Affairs Support Element (JPASE)



- Sole expeditionary joint Public Affairs capability for joint military operations worldwide.
- Premiere Public Affairs and Strategic Communication trainer for the joint force.
- Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff designated joint proponent and sponsor for Public Affairs



**An early-entry capability enabling the Joint Force Commander to gain and maintain the initiative in the information domain**



# Intelligence-Quick Reaction Team (I-QRT)



- Deploys trained and experienced intelligence personnel globally no later than N+72
- Up to 4 x Targeteers and 4 x Collection Managers deploy in support of warfighting commanders
- 6 operational I-QRT deployments in 2007/2008 including
  - 1 deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom (Baghdad) Multi-National Forces-Iraq
  - 2 deployments in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom
  - 1 deployment to International Security Assistance Force – X
  - 1 deployment support of Task Force Ramadi
  - 1 deployment to U.S. Africa Command



**Provides rapid response to fill High Demand/Low Density gap between requirements and force provision response timeline**
