LOG IT WG – SCOPE

Definitions and Skill Sets

- **Goal is to reach consensus concerning:**
 - Definitions and skill sets

- **Competencies we need to define (not re-write)**
 - Define LOG IT competencies for logistics IT professionals
 - Define LOG IT competencies for all logisticians

- **Key functional elements for logistics IT competencies (Skill Sets)**
 - Management of required logistics information
 - One foot in IT and the other in functional logistics capabilities (EX: USTC J3 and GTN21, DLA IDE and BSM, DISA GCSS and global Communication)
 - Knows where and how to get at actionable logistics information, across services, industry, combatant commands and organizations
 - Knows how information is/should be captured, relayed and displayed
 - GCSS baseline data requirements and descriptions a good place to start
 - Ensure we include evolving AIT, UID and RFID
 - Knows how LOG IT supports evolving business practices and able to help those processes evolve as IT capabilities evolve (EX: AIT in distribution)
 - CSS AMO (Army) is a good example of this type of future LOG IT professional

LOG IT WG – SCOPE

Integrated Logistics IT Workforce

- **We must make the case for the Integrated LOG IT Workforce in:**
 - Government civilians
 - Industry – specialties
 - Military
 - Academia – public and private – resource generation and sustainment
- **Ensure other logistics professionals do not take LOG IT for granted**
 - Good logistics management is fully dependent on great logistics information
