# DoD Automatic Test Systems Executive Directorate (ATS ED)

---

- DoD ATS Management Board (AMB) last met at AUTOTESTCON
- Service Board Member turnover:
  - We announced at the September ATC meeting that Navy, Marine Corps and Air Force all had new members
  - Col Myers, the Army member, will be transitioning AMB duties to his relief, Col Boruff, but hopes to remain involved
- IPT leadership changes:
  - Jay Romania (Army) will lead the “NxTest IPT”
  - “Framework Working Group” become a stand-alone IPT and will continue under Mike Malesich’s (Navy) leadership
  - Melissa Alton (Navy) will lead the “ATS Processes IPT”
  - “TPS IPT” will continue under Kevin Dusch (Navy)
  - “IA IPT” will continue under Chris Dosch (Navy)
  - “JOLATS IPT” was previously disestablished

# Technical IPT Initiatives

---

- Joint TPS IPT
  - Meeting this week at Warner Robins AFB
  - Focus is to define the Future Programming Environment (FPE)
    - Review each Service's software applications
    - Capture user stories
    - Translate into requirements
    - Draft a Capabilities Requirements Document (CDD) for the IPT's use
  - Updating Charter
- Joint NxTest IPT
  - Plans to meet in January 2012
  - Will likely establish several sub-IPTs to focus individual skills
    - EO, Interface, RF, Analog/Digital, and Software
  - Updating Charter
- Joint Framework IPT
  - Continues to “lead” and support the IEEE SCC20 Test Systems standards activities
  - Working closely with the TPS IPT on the FPE initiative
  - Charter has been updated and signed by the DoD ATS ED
