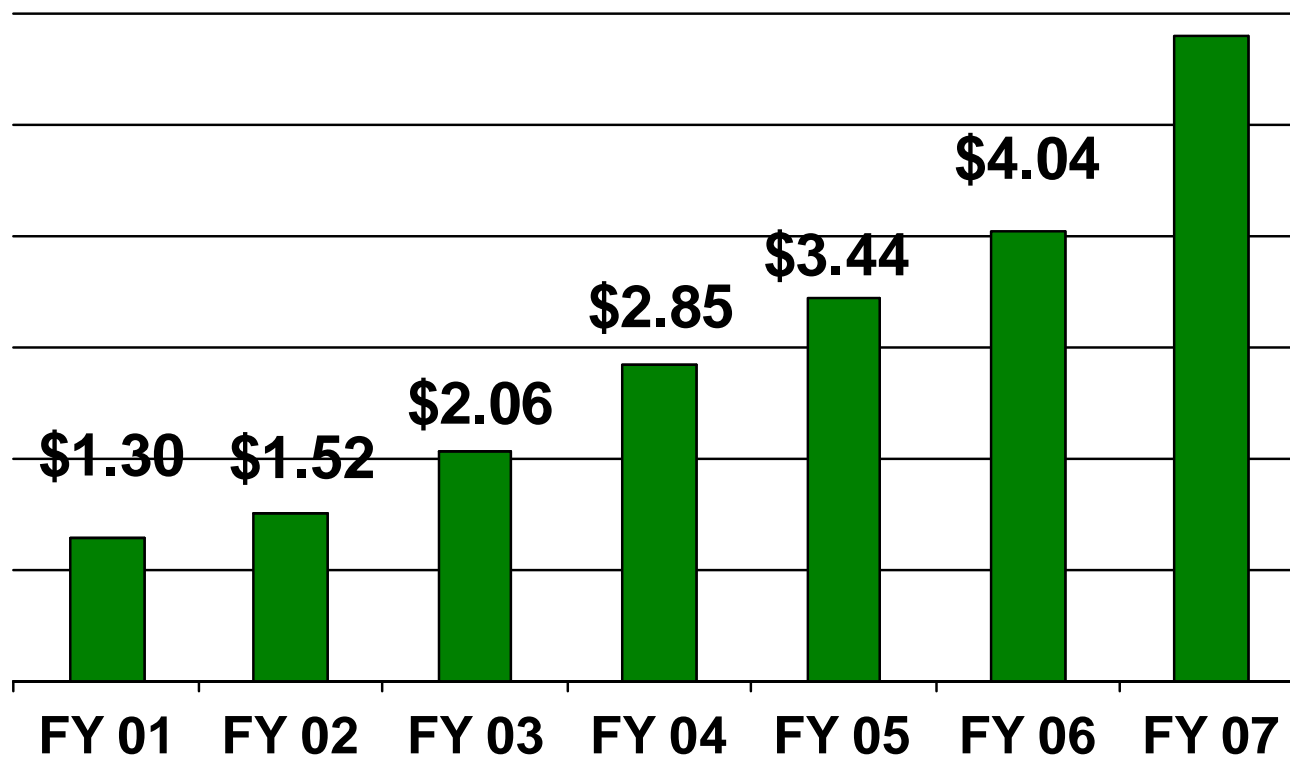

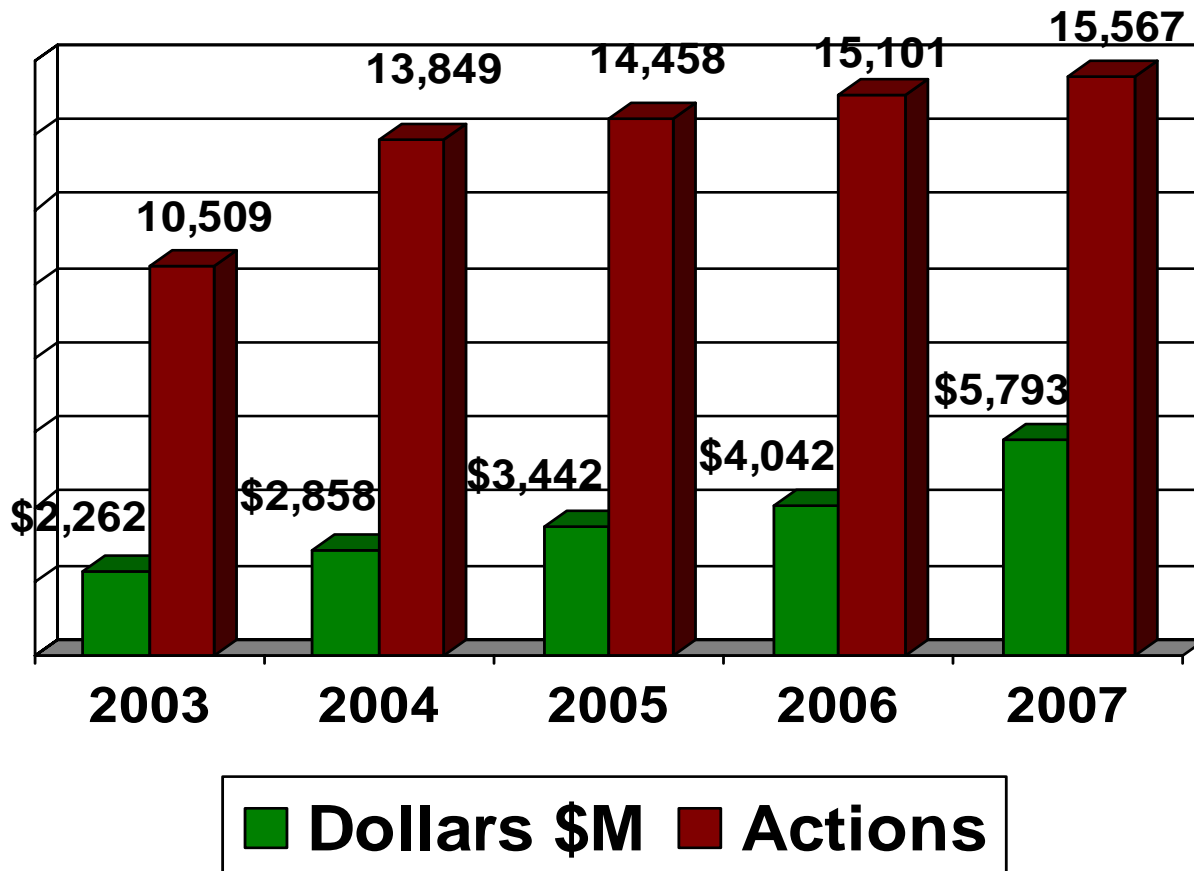


# \$ Obligated In Billions





# Dollars Obligated / Actions Awarded





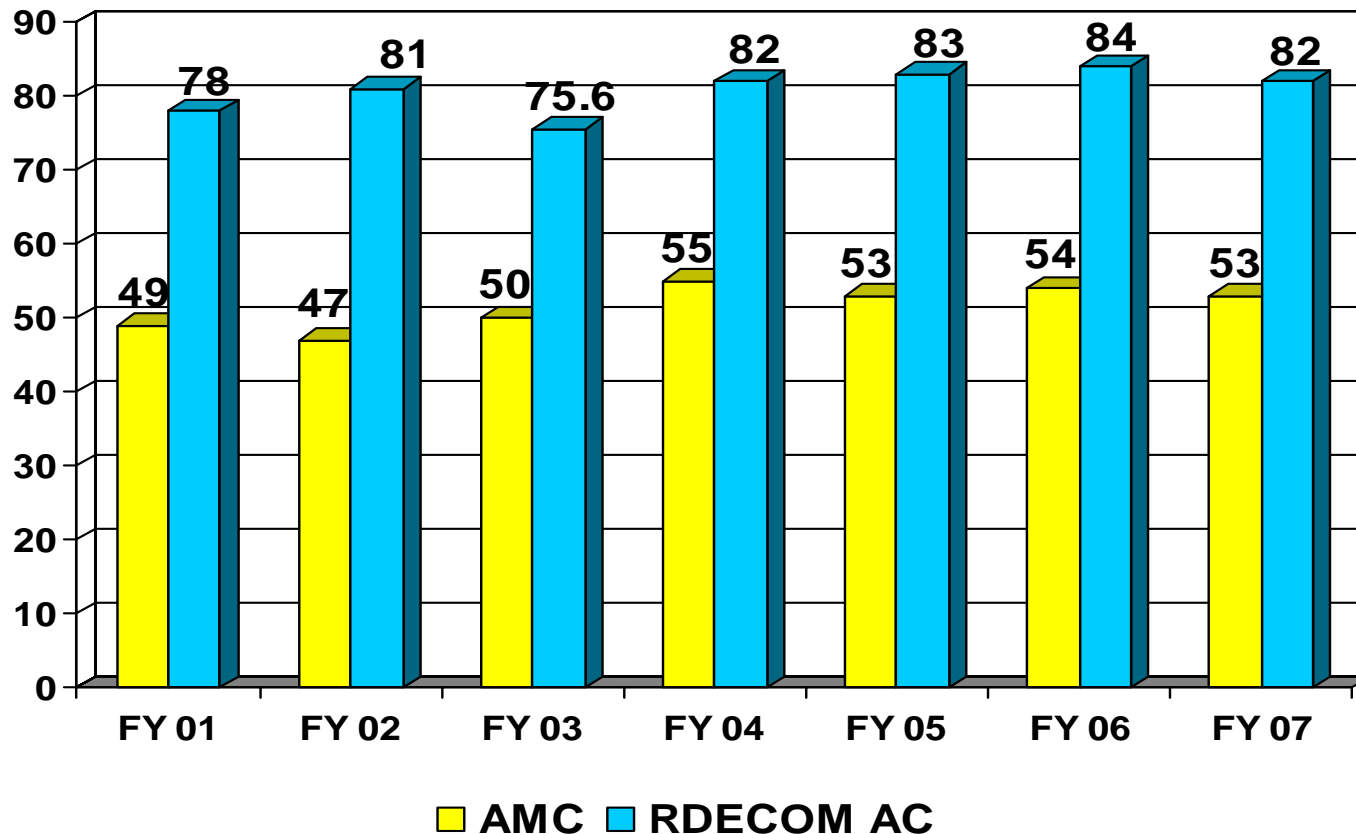
# Obligations vs Personnel Strength

# **Proposed Rule with Request for Comment:**

## **Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement; Mandatory Use of Wide Area WorkFlow (DFARS Case 2006-D049).**

- Requires use of the Wide Area WorkFlow- Receipt and Acceptance (WAWF-RA) electronic system for submitting and processing payment requests under DoD contracts.
- 15 October 2007 closing date for comments.



# **Proposed Rule with Request for Comment:**

## **Federal Acquisition Regulation; FAR Case 2006-031, Enhanced Access for Small Business.**

- Creates a higher ceiling (\$150,000 vs. \$50,000) for small businesses to appeal a contracting officer's final decision under the small claims procedures.
- October 22, 2007 closing date for comments.



## **Final Rule:**

### **Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) – Reporting Requirement of Subcontractor Award Data (FAR Case 2006–029)**

- Pilot program to test the collection and accession of subcontract award data.
- Subcontracts awarded and funded with Federal appropriated funds will eventually be disclosed to the public in a single searchable website.



## **FAR Open Cases:**

### **Post Award Debriefings--Task and Delivery Orders.**

- Requires post award debriefings be provided, as requested, to disappointed offerors on task and delivery orders in excess of \$5 million (including options).
- Report due 10 Oct 2007.



# FAR Open Cases:

## Strengthening Competitive Procedures on Multiple Award Contracts for Services.

- Competition requirements in addition to “Fair Opportunity”.
- Actions \$5M and above.
  - ✓ Clear requirements.
  - ✓ Reasonable response period.
  - ✓ Evaluation factors & subfactors.
  - ✓ Justify trade-off of quality and past performance versus cost or price in award decision.
- Report due 10/31/2007.

Query DAU to determine interest in obtaining Industry presentations.
