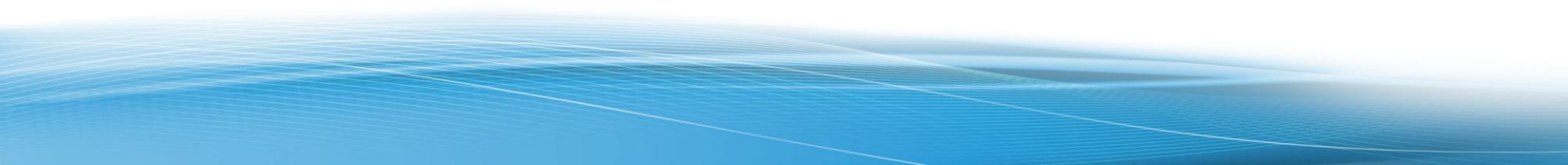

Decontamination Sector Profile

- 21 Contacts Listed in sector
- 12 Active Companies
- Company Size
 - 40% Large Businesses
 - 20% Medium Businesses
 - 40% Small Businesses
- APBI participation is close to 50%
- 80% believe JPMs are aware of their programs
- 20% indicate their programs are “active” with JPM or DARPA
- Prioritized requests
 - More data on 18 month opportunities
 - More operational data
 - Reduce CWA challenge for non-skin applications
 - To Reduce thermal burden
 - To Reduce costs

- Rumor is that DoD may raise priority for Chem-bio countermeasures over next two years.
- Is there any thought being given to a concerted effort to make JPEO-CBD expertise available to First Responders?

New products

- Almost every company was willing to openly discuss their projects in detail. However,
- “How will JPEO use information on new products?” Concern was expressed that sharing new product information with the JPEO might alienate or worse yet embarrass PMs as it is PM’s job to brief JPEO. Companies don’t want to cause a PM to be asked about a new technology unless the PM is fully briefed.
- One company indicated that aggregated nanocrystals of metal oxides could provide superior adsorptive properties for ammonia, chlorine, pesticides, acids, and solvents while reducing the weight of breathable self-decontaminating materials.
