

# **GOCO Update October 2010**

## **Accomplishments**

- Modernization projects addressing long needed improvements**
- BRAC relocations on track**
- All facilities have supplied IBAT/MSR input**

## **Issues**

- Status of MCOM management of some GOCO services is unclear. Pilot GOCO's not receiving funding**
- DCAA demands are choking procurement cycles and add little value**

# Strategic Concerns

- **IDIQ style procurements with quantity ranges starting at very low numbers cause problems with accurate, fair pricing and discourage capital investment.**
  - **Consider specifying most likely quantities with contractual protection for significant departures (for example, non-recurring investment recovery clauses, formulas for adjusting price given unusually high or low yearly orders)**
- **Increased need to use international chemical sources**
  - **Likely to worsen with lower volumes**
  - **Should stockpiling be considered?**
- **Tighter environmental standards will drive operating cost and/or capital improvement needs**
- **Sufficient funding for infrastructure and facilities as budgets tighten**
