 - Accomplishments
 - Improved processing time for PM Major Defense Equipment assessments
 - Drafted Standard Operating Procedure for staffing Foreign Disclosure Officer reviews of FMS technical information and briefings
 - Developed recommendations to expand the scope of charter to add a strategic level body of decision-makers
 - In support of US Munitions List Rewrite coordinated among PMs and developed a methodology to identify and categorize critical technologies (format later adopted by DASA DE&C)
 - Expanded membership to include key players from JMC Security Assistance
 - Allows real-time resolution of FMS policy/procedure issues at functional level
