Eric Sorensen is an All-Source Intelligence Analyst in the FBI's Domestic Terrorism Analysis Unit (DTAU), Counterterrorism Analysis Section, Directorate of Intelligence. Prior to joining DTAU in June 2006, Mr. Sorensen worked in the Counterterrorism Division's Terrorist Watch & Warning Unit, writing FBI Intelligence Bulletins on terrorism trends and tactics for distribution to the nation's federal, state, local, and tribal law enforcement agencies. Mr. Sorensen joined the FBI in March 2003 as a Presidential Management Intern after receiving a Ph.D. in Biblical Studies (University of Chicago, 2001). His other degrees include an M.Div. (Harvard Divinity School, 1991), an M.A. in Classics (University of Washington, 1987), and a B.A. in English and Classics (Pacific Lutheran University, 1984). In October 2008, Mr. Sorensen was asked to serve as the FBI's Analytic Outreach Coordinator. In this role, he promotes engagement between the FBI's Counterintelligence, Counterterrorism, Criminal, Cyber, and WMD Intelligence Analysts and subject matter experts residing outside of the Intelligence Community (in academia, think tanks, the private sector, etc.). His presentation, "Insight through Outreach," provides an overview of the FBI's efforts to engage outside subject matter expertise in the context of the Intelligence Community's larger Analytic Outreach initiative.
