Speaker Biography

Mr. David Cattler

Deputy Director for Intelligence, Joint Staff

Mr. Cattler assumed duties as the Deputy Director for Intelligence, Joint Staff J2 in June 2010. Prior to this assignment, he served in the Office of the Director of National Intelligence as Principal Deputy National Intelligence Officer (NIO) for Military Issues. In this capacity, he served as a senior advisor to the Director of National Intelligence (DNI) regarding military strategic, operational, tactical and technical developments worldwide. He also served as the DNI's Deputy Issue Topic Manager for Foreign Military Combat Capabilities and Advanced Conventional Weapons and Proliferation. He joined the Senior National Intelligence Service in May 2007.

A 1993 graduate of the United States Naval Academy, Mr. Cattler was commissioned as a surface warfare officer and served in two Aegis cruisers, USS Antietam (CG 54) and USS Chancellorsville (CG 62). He deployed to the Western Pacific Ocean, Arabian Gulf, and the Caribbean Sea in support of Operation SOUTHERN WATCH and counter-narcotics operations. At the conclusion of sea duty, he was designated as a Navy Foreign Area Officer. His first assignment in the intelligence community was as an air warfare analyst assigned to the Strike Projection, Evaluation, and Anti-Air Warfare Research (SPEAR) Division of the Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI). After leaving active duty, Mr. Cattler took a position as a defense consultant in northern Virginia.

Shortly after the 9/11 terrorist attacks, Mr. Cattler returned to government service with the Office of Naval Intelligence, and served as an analyst of the naval strategy, doctrine, and plans of China and other Asian states. He joined the Navy staff at the Pentagon in 2003 and served as the Deputy Assistant Director of Naval Intelligence for Intelligence Support. Mr. Cattler was the first director of Deep Red, a Navy organization providing alternative analysis strategic insights to Navy leadership and operational decision makers about adversaries and the war fighting environment.

Mr. Cattler holds a Master of Policy Management degree from Georgetown University and Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science. He is a graduate of the National Defense Intelligence College, the US Naval War College, and was a Senior Fellow at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's Seminar XXI: Foreign Politics, International Relations and the National Interest. He also has completed the Defense Leadership and Management Program (DLAMP) and EXCEL, an Intelligence Community executive leader development program at Northwestern University.
