#### NDIA HSI Committee Liaison for SAE G-45



- DoD has selected the Society of Automotive Engineers' (SAE) G-45 Committee to develop an HSI Standard
- Goal
  - Define minimum tasking requirements for affordable, responsive contractor HSI programs to optimize humansystem performance, and minimize risk and customer ownership costs
- To be applied to future DoD contracts
- DoD to monitor standard implementation, effectiveness, cost, and benefits once adopted
- NDIA SE HSI Committee participation

# SAE G-45 HSI Standard Update



Steve Merriman

- Completed first 100% draft of the HSI Best Practice Standard
- Completed full G-45 committee review of the draft Standard
- Preparing for review by a group of senior HSI SMEs from government and industry
- Still on track for December 2018 release
- HSI domain requirements status
  - HFE, Training, and Safety/OH (Complete)
  - Manpower and Habitability (NPS)
  - Personnel (?)
  - Force Protection (?)

# MIL-STD 1472H Update



Owen Seely, Jeff Markiewicz, Eric Stohr

- MIL-STD-1472H Department of Defense Design Criteria Standard – Human Engineering
- NAVSEA is the preparing authority for the version H update to MIL-STD-1472
- Kicked off in 2015, over 20 sub-groups have been developing new and updated content for an initial draft
- Current review and publication schedule
  - Intermediate Review begins: 10/31/17 (Delayed draft still in work)
  - Government/Industry and Senior Leadership Review begins: 5/1/18
  - Submitted for publication: 10/31/18
  - Publication: 11/21/18

# **MIL-HDBK Update**



Owen Seely, Jeff Markiewicz, Eric Stohr

- Initiated in Sept 2016 as a Government companion piece to the G-45 Standard Practice for HSI
  - Provides guidance and instruction for Government to implement and oversee an HSI program
  - Not proscriptive, but provides a link to the Practice Standard, which is used to levy HSI on Contract
- 5 authoring teams provided inputs to zero version draft; reviewed during 2 November meeting
- Revisions, structural changes, information sharing, and new content due for first version draft; Feb 2018
- Multiple ~3 month review and revision cycles will culminate in a final draft submitted to Naval DepSO; Nov 2018

#### Strategic Goals


- Through partnership and collaboration to:
