What is the Problem?

Different Perspectives

- Government Wants a “How To” Guide That Will Appropriately Test Contractors’ Systems
- Industry Reluctant to Strenuously Test Systems

Different Perspectives

Example: IBR Guide

Industry and Government Need: What should be expected/ done during an IBR?

- Government Expected: Details On How To Perform An IBR (How Industry Does One)
- Industry Provided: General Description of Intent and Results of IBRs

Result:

- IBR Guide is Very Accurate, but...
- Government Can't Use It – So Offices Developed Their Own How To Guides (Several)

OMB Looking Now

Need: 1. A “How To” Guide For New OMB Contractors

2. A “How To” Guide Telling OMB Offices How To Perform Reviews (Compliance Series and IBRs)

Can We Do This??

- Industry Has A Good Standard (30 Years in development with DOD)
- Industry Has Good Systems – Should Be Able To Do A “How To” (Intent Document?)
- Industry and Government (DCMA and Procuring Offices) Have Performed Reviews - Should Jointly Be Able To Do A “How To” Document
 - Compliance Review Series
 - IBR
 - Surveillance

We Should Be Able To Do This

Time's A-Wastin'

- Experience Base Is “Moving On”
- We Need To Tap Their Experience Base
 - They Lived Through The Chaos of The 60s/70s
 - Current Advocates Won't Even Know They Are Making The Same Mistakes
 - Example: “What's A JIG?”
- Business Case Evaluations Are Getting Agencies' Attention
 - Given No Standard, Agencies Will Do Their Own Thing

We Can't Afford Not To Do This!!

- Too Many Agencies Exist To Have Equally Many “How To” Guides For Each “Special” Case
 - Expensive For Government To Develop All These Guides
 - Expensive For Contractors To Have Systems To Meet All The Agency-Unique Guidelines
 - This Duplication = Less \$ To Pursue Technical Requirements = Waste of Taxpayers' Dollars
- A Validated Contractor For One Agency Should Be Validated For The Others As Well.
 - What Is Really Unique About EV From One Agency To The Next?? - NOTHING!

Focus Topics To Consider

 - Must Set the “Rules”
- Pre-Award IBRs
 - Explore Possibilities
