

(RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT AND ACQUISITIONS)





- Navy focal point for EVM
- Ensure effective and consistent implementation of EVM across all Navy acquisition programs
- Assist Program Managers in using EVM data to better manage programs
- Provide ASN(RD&A) with timely & reliable information on status of Navy's programs
- Ensure personnel with EVM responsibilities have necessary training and toolsets
- Work with SYSCOMS to develop an EVM competency capability

- Monthly EVM analysis
- Program review support as needed
- Management Assessments to help program offices identify management process issues
- Provide EVM charts for Dashboard

Current Activities



- Focus on improving EVM processes, oversight, and managerial analysis on shipbuilding programs
 - Recent and ongoing audits at shipyards
 - Apply lessons learned and process across the Naval Acquisition Enterprise
- EVM performance is presented to ASN(RDA) at monthly portfolio reviews
- Investigating new metrics for leadership review
- Standardizing schedule and EVM information to support portfolio analysis



Opportunities to Improve EVM



- As an industry, we need to be better at managing with EVM data
 - Currently discuss EVM performance and conduct analysis
 - Need to focus on corrective actions and mitigating overruns and schedule slips
- Better dialogue between customer and supplier
 - Seek to understand the each others' position, constraints, and business processes
- Focus on managerial action rather than the metrics reported
