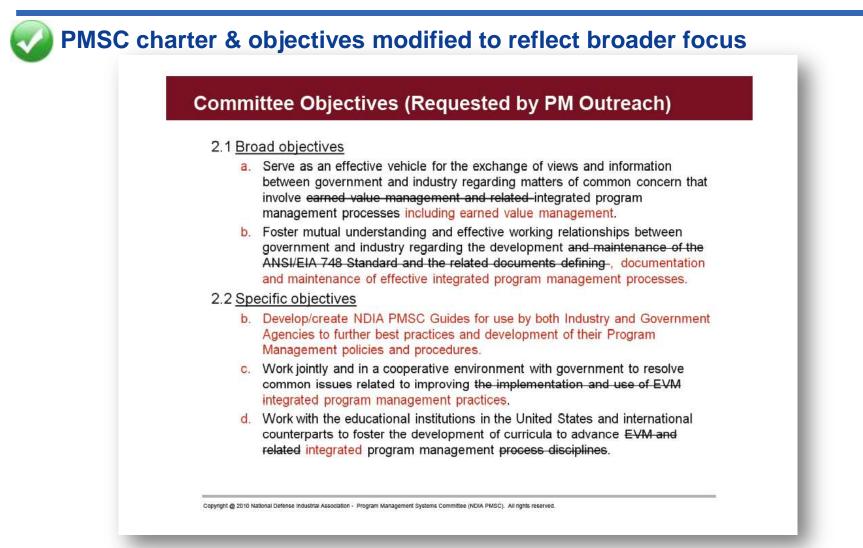
<u>Mission:</u> Broaden the focus and membership of the PMSC to influence acquisition policy and share best practices among program management professionals.

- Initiate a campaign to increase program manager participation in PMSC.



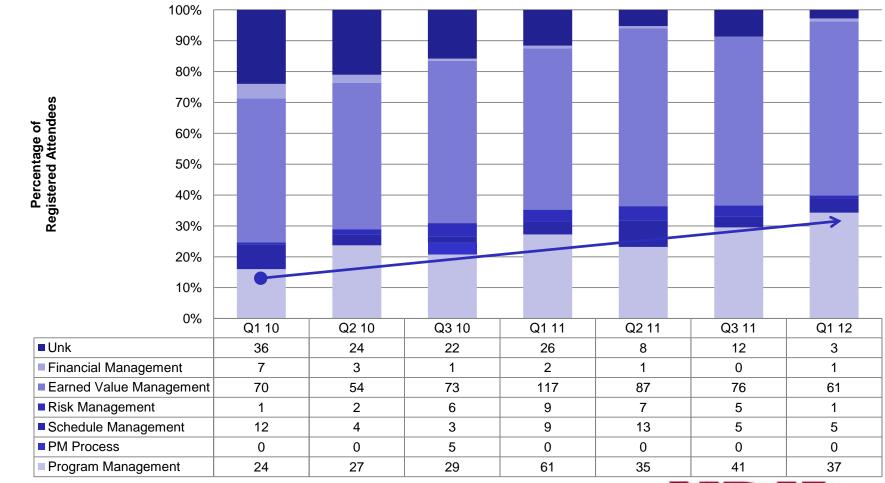
Objective #1: Modify PMSC charter and objectives

- Build a topic-based Group for Integrated Program Management professionals.


Metrics - Evaluate effectiveness of site after 9 months based on following:

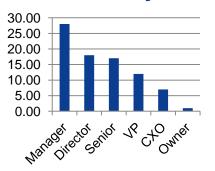

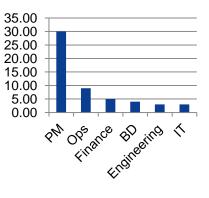
PMSC LinkedIn Group Evolution

Function

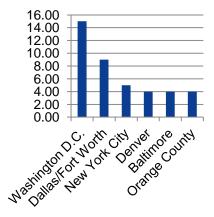




Metro Area

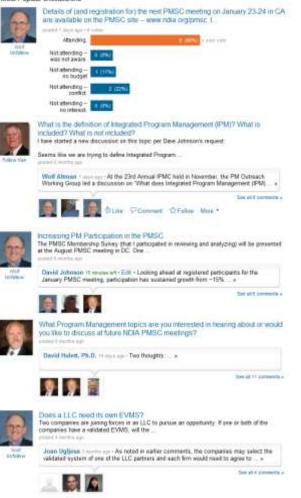

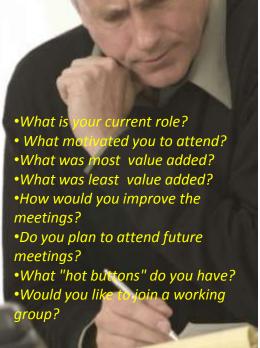
