

 - Ground Combat Vehicle (GCV) Program
 - Family of Medium Tactical Vehicles (FMTV)
 - Ohio Class Replacement-SSBN(X)




B02-12-101 v 2.3 FY 2013 Budget

FY10 - 17: -21%/-\$156B





Projections (red bars) assume FYDP plus \$44.2 billion annual placeholders for OCO in years beyond FY 2013


