- Formalize and document assessment criteria
- Document will be one element of providing consistency across surveillance and compliance reviews
- Planned as collaborative effort among DoD components
- Will look to leverage current body of knowledge
- Anticipated release date 1st Qtr CY13



- Current version issued July 2012
- Initially release May 2012 to provide a reference in performing program analysis
 - EVMS Annex of Program Assessment Reports (PAR)
 - Contract Performance section of Program Assessment Charts (PAC)
- Comments received from NDIA PMSC on August 6, 2012
 - Based on older version of document
 - All comments reviewed and adjudicated
 - Changes made on August 9, 2012 pending release



 The term "tools" at DCMA means any document, template, or software application that assists in accomplishing procedures defined in instructions

- Focus is on enterprise approach to tool development
 - Standardized use of tools across geographic boundaries
 - Commonality of tools across functional boundaries
- Deployment of standardized/common tools in sync with instructions will increase efficiency and effectiveness





- Suite of applications on the DCMA intranet developed by DCMA to cover a wide range of functions (EVMS uses applications below)
 - Contract Receipt & Review
 - Contract Technical Review
 - Delegations
 - Contract Business Analysis Repository
 - First Line Supervisor Review
 - Program Assessment Report
 - Corrective Action Request
 - Surveillance Plan
- These applications feed an integrated database (IDB)



- EITS is a dashboard that presents information generated by eTools and stored in the IDB
- Features progressively built through successive releases – currently release 4
- Exploring EVMS dashboard requirements for release 5
 - Provide situational awareness within DCMA for ACAT I programs
 - Leverage DoD investments made in EVM-CR
 - Integrate EVMS data with business system status (ACAT I only)





Tools: COTS Software Applications

DEFENSE CONTRACT MANAGEMENT AGENCY

- DCMA has deployed COTS Software Applications to EVMS Specialists to enable in depth analysis of contractor EVMS data
 - Schedule and cost oriented software to enable analysis in native file formats
 - Analysis applications used in conjunction with schedule and cost software
 - Standard file format (UNCEFACT/XML) may enable some consolidation of deployed software
