#### Hub Core Functions

- Advocate the Department's implementation of EVM by executing the role and responsibilities of DFARS Subpart 242.302 (S-71)
- Conduct EVMS reviews to verify initial and continuing compliance of contractor management systems
- Support CMOs in executing System Surveillance; CAR review/approval
- Provide assistance to CMOs for Major Program Support


#### Corporate Group Functions

  - Enhance standardization







## Scope of DCMA Operations EVM

- DCMA Operations CMO's conduct system surveillance at 191 contractor sites
  - Eastern Region
    - 79 EVMS specialists conducting System Surveillance
  - Central Region
    - 40 EVMS specialists conducting System Surveillance
  - Western Region
    - 72 EVMS specialists conducting System Surveillance
- Local EVMS specialists issue Level I and Low Risk GL Level II CARs through the CMO command
  - Hubs have review & approval of High Risk Level II and higher



- FY15 Schedule planning begins in May 14
  - 1QFY15 suppliers will be established in July 14 and notified
- Standard Interpretation for System Evaluation
  - Increase consistency with a peer review process
  - Use of improved analytics / test steps to ensure consistency
  - Focus on system issues, not human error
- Corrective Action Verification
  - Measurement against agreed upon criteria and thresholds
  - Data Driven assessments when and where possible!
