- APM is the subject matter owner for Earned Value Management in the UK
  - APM Guidelines 2<sup>nd</sup> edition, ISBN 978-1-903494-26-4
  - Earned Value Management Handbook, ISBN: 978-1-903494-50-9
- NDIA IPMD, through SAE International's Technical Standards Board, is the subject matter owner for Earned Value Management in the US
  - EIA-748-C: Earned Value Management Systems reaffirmed March 2013
- APM and NDIA agree:
  - These EVMS guidelines are equivalent in their intent
  - To publicize this agreement to Government and Industry organizations
  - Encourage Government and Industry organizations to recognize the equivalency of EIA-748 and APM Guidelines in contracts, partnering agreements and other applicable business transactions

This Equivalency Agreement for EVM Guidelines is a reaffirmation from the original Agreement dated July 1, 2004.

#### EVM Operating Environment Update

- DoD EVMS Interpretation Guide (EVMSIG) ECD 1/30
  - DoD agencies/organizations (DCMA, IC, NAVSEA SUPSHIP, DCAA) charged with conducting initial and continuing EVMS compliance activities will establish amplifying agency-level procedures to clarify how the DoD EVMSIG is being implemented and provide guidance for attribute evaluation methods and tests.
- DODi 5000.02 Table 8 EVM Requirements -1/7/15
  - Work scope should be measurable & discrete, otherwise program offices should follow process to obtain DFARS deviation
  - DFAR Deviation Process Maturing
- Schedule Margin PARCA Memo 12/17
  - DoD Clarification of Purpose & Use of Schedule Margin per IPMR DiD
  - Joint Meeting Planned to Ensure Consistent Interpretation
