

## IPMR DID Data Exchange Working Group - Charter

## **Overview**

Short term effort to facilitate PARCA and DCMA transition to a *DoD* owned data exchange format for next revision of the IPMR DID (EVM-CR) as well as DCMA compliance/surveillance activities

- Intent is to conclude work effort as quickly as possible (spring/summer 2017)
  to facilitate the next revision of the IPMR DID
  - Revision focuses on the schedule and cost performance data requirements instead of describing the content of paper based forms
- Migrate from the UN/CEFACT XML Schema and data exchange instructions (DEIs) to a simpler data interchange format (JSON) and business rule DEIs
  - JSON structures are based on arrays and records intended for the purpose of exchanging data
  - Collection of data tables to convey schedule and cost performance data in a software neutral format
  - Reflect lessons learned from ANSI X12 and UN/CEFACT XML standards development processes

### **Overview/Mission:**

A forum for industry's EVMS practitioners to raise and discuss EVMS implementation issues. The goal is to identify common issues, gather facts and supporting data, formulate industry positions, and develop recommendations for resolution.

  - Advises IPMD Board of changes in policy or regulation that need to be immediately incorporated into one or more guides
  - Accepts out of cycle change requests to determine best course of action (appropriate and warranted, immediate update required or can hold for next regular update)

  - Push frequent emails out to membership with info for meetings or volunteer needs
