IDA Background

DPAP tasked IDA to

- Investigate whether DoD's policies, regulations and practices on flow-down requirements:
 - Discourage subcontractors from participating in DoD acquisitions
 - Are costly
 - Discourage small businesses, contractors for commercial items, nontraditional defense contractors and universities from participating
 - If so, what should Congress and/or DoD do about it?
- Document the rationale and cost drivers of Bid and Proposal budgets in contractors' overhead rates
 - Some congressional stakeholders believe B&P should be eliminated or reduced
 - DPAP seeking to educate committees on B&P rationale, cost drivers, rules, regulations and practices
