# Discussions from Working Group 26 April '17

- CADE and DCARC attended the WG meeting
  - Would like to be a part of the conversation and hear from industry on how CAPE can be less burdensome:
- FlexFile Draft DID (13 April 2017) discussions:
  - Tailoring of the CSDR Plan Standards (templates)
    - WBS identified in the five page CSDR/EVM Co-Plan
  - Differences of the new term "Forecast At Complete" vs EAC
  - Definition of "Cost Account Code": Management Control Point
  - Government may ask for up to 12 additional data fields
  - Data Group F; three Allocation methods (Data model tables)
    - Data not typically found in industry tool systems
  - Vendor status to meet JSON XML Data Exchange rqmts: DEI and FFS
  - Next CSDR Focus Group meeting 23-24 May 2017
- Discussed the new reporting requirements (draft DIDs dated 13 April 2017) for 1921-Q, 1921-T, 1921-M/R
