

CSDR Working Group - 2017 Task Plan and Status

Products / Initiatives:

- Establish communication between NDIA-IPMD and CAPE/DCARC
 - Keep NDIA IPMD current on the changing environment and reporting requirements from CAPE
 - Provide industry comments on draft DIDs, etc.
 - Consider Collaboration Meetings
- Assess the need for any additional IPMD documents regarding CAPE

Tasks and Due Dates:

- Continue to provide detail comments to the FlexFile, 1921-T, 1921-Q, and 1921-M/R Draft DIDs **plus a revised SRDR DID – comments due on 28 April**

Concerns and/or Collaboration:

- Challenge to engage industry Engineering and Maintenance organizations to identify comments to the 1921-T, 1921-Q and 1921-M/R DIDs
- Lack of software vendors to generate the JSON/XML for the FlexFiles
