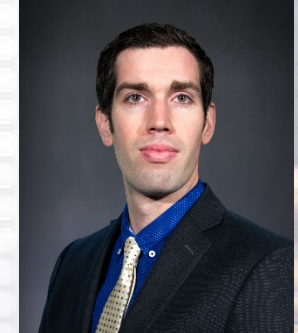
Overview/Mission:
