

CSDR Working Group - 2018 Task Plan and Status

Products / Initiatives:

- **Establish communication between NDIA-IPMD and CAPE/DCARC**
 - Keep NDIA IPMD current on the changing environment and reporting requirements from CAPE and CADE
 - Provide industry comments on draft DIDs, etc.
 - Consider Collaboration Meetings
- **Assess the need for any additional IPMD documents regarding CAPE**

Tasks and Due Dates:

- **Continue (?) to provide comments to the FlexFile, 1921-T, 1921-Q, and 1921-M/R DIDs**
- **Coordinate the support of the new Draft CBOM DID**

Concerns and/or Collaboration:

- **Challenge to engage industry Engineering and Maintenance organizations to identify comments to the 1921-T, 1921-Q and 1921-M/R DIDs**
- **Lack of software vendors to generate the JSON files for the FlexFile DID**

Other Notable Points:

- **Year-to-Date Hours Volunteered: TBD**
- **Number of People Who Participated: 20 people on the distribution list**

- **CAPE/DCARC attended the WG meeting**
 - **“Straw man” FlexFile DID posted to CADE website (dated 15 Nov 2015)**
Currently voluntary
 - **Currently have 9 volunteers to pilot the FlexFile DID on current contracts**
 - **Hope to have a total of 36 pilots for 2018**
 - **Testing full DID and JSON files**
 - **Pilots are using Excel or CVS files. DCARC “Creation” tool converts file to JSON format for importing files to CADE Portal**
 - **This tool is a temporary transition process that will be discontinued**
 - **Industry will still have to make or buy third party tools**
 - **Still in the walk phase.**
 - **Document what works or doesn’t work from the pilots**
 - **Looking to eventually get the 80% solution**
 - **Execute the pilots with a sense of fairness to both communities**
 - **What is viable for industry and needed for Cost Estimators**
 - **We requested that CADE share results with the IPMD WG**
 - **We discussed the possibility of tailoring of requirements: via CDRL**
 - **Based on results of the FlexFile Pilots the Nov 2017 DID will be updated**
 - **Industry will have to meet the requirements of this “Final” DID**

- **The IPMD Working Group does want to stay engaged and be the conduit with CADE regarding the new /proposed DIDs also under consideration.**
 - **1921-Technical Data DID**
 - **1921-Quantity Data DID**
 - **1921-Maintenaince & Repair DID**
 - **Consolidated Bill Of Material DID**
 - **Found out that CADE is considering an update to the 1921-3 DID**
- **Working Group will be informed of all Focus Group meetings and Training hosted by CADE this year**
 - **CBOM Conference planned for early March 2018.**
