Panel: Gary Humphreys



Her current role includes: Managing EVMS compliance across all EVM programs, providing all internal EVM training to include a CAM Certification program and is the lead for all JSR/IBR activity as well.

Subcontract MR Survey Background & Purpose



Background:

The NDIA Integrated Program Management Division, Clearinghouse Working Group was asked by industry to address the handling and reporting of subcontract management reserve (MR).

Purpose:

Provide recommendations for compliant methods in handling and reporting subcontract MR.

Subcontract MR survey results



- Thirty-nine (39) responses were received.
- Pattern emerged of two (2) primary methods, with reporting variations
 - 1) Subcontract MR in Prime's Performance Measurement Baseline (PMB)
 - 2) Subcontract MR in Prime's Management Reserve (MR), reported in Format 5
- However, both PMB and MR method had mixed results relative to Government assessments
 - Six of 39 responses indicated the Government had an issue with subcontract MR being included in Prime PMB
 - One of 39 responses indicated the Government had an issue with subcontract MR being reported in the Prime MR and explained in IPMR Format 5.
 - Both common approaches resulted in a Corrective Action Request (CAR) being issued – from over five years ago.
- Panel Discussion and engagement with Government will hopefully allow suppliers to select method best suited to their management styles
 - Survey indicative that could be an interpretation issue, more than an execution issue

Subcontract MR survey results



Several key responses listed below:

 "EIA 748 clearly states that MR is not part of the PMB. By its nature, it is not defined work. Some customers are wanting to see Sub MR reported as part of the baseline to reconcile to their total sub cost."

 "The contract and/or subcontract SOW and IPMR CDRL can dictate how the customer would like to integrate the MR. EIA-748 should not dictate or be prescriptive in the handling of the Subcontractors MR."

Recommendations:



As a result of the input from industry partners, the NDIA Integrated Program Management Division, Prime/Subcontract Management Working Group recommends two actions:

- If Earned Value Management System Description document includes specific detail on how to establish Sub's MR, then follow that process for all applicable contracts
- 2) If Earned Value Management System Description document does <u>not</u> include specific details, program can select method best suited to nature of work and in a manner compliant with policies, procedures and other areas of System Description. Document selected process (e.g. Program Directive).

The company EVM System Description document should identify approaches to handling and reporting subcontract Management Reserve (MR) and company EVMS subject matter experts (SMEs) should provide guidance.

You can consult your DCMA EVMS point of contact with questions... but remember your customer.

These recommendation will:

- Give Prime flexibility to determine the best method for each specific contract and avoid a "one size fits all" requirement for handling and reporting subcontract MR.
- Opportunity to address potential issues with the Government/customer in the early stages of executing a contract.



If subcontract MR is in included in the Prime PMB, has there been an issue raised by DCMA?



Both methodologies have pros and cons and since we've used both methodologies, depending on Program Manager decisions, I don't have a preference either way. Pros for having the subcontract MR in a PPKG in the Primes PMB include having the entire subcontract value in the PMB making reconciliation and Format 2 easier. Cons for having the subcontractor MR in the Primes PMB include it not having specific scope tied to it in the PPKG and needing to make additional BCR changes for the PPKG when the subcontractor changes its PMB in order to reflect the correct time phasing of the overall subcontract in the Primes PMB. Pros for including the subcontractor MR in the Primes MR include knowing what the overall MR picture is for the program as a whole and fewer BCR changes to the Primes PMB. Cons for having the subcontractor MR in the Primes MR include the additional tracking necessary to hedge or fence the subcontract MR and track it, as well as the Primes Program Manager sometimes believing he has the right to tell the subcontractor what they can use their MR for. Also, if the MR is not tracked appropriately, their is the chance the Prime could issue subcontractor MR to the Prime causing discrepancies in the total Primes PMB to contract value.

Including subcontractor MR in the prime PMB doesn't work simply because it is budget that cannot be earned, and if the sub doesn't use it all, there will be a discrepancy where the sub reported BCWP at completion does not equal the prime's BAC for the subcontractor control account. I think this is an obvious problem for most EV experts to see, and a reason why this is such an issue. I may be oversimplifying this, but to me, subcontractor data should be a simple roll-up. The prime creates a planning package or SLPP with an estimate of the subcontractor's costs. Once the subcontract is issued and the sub completes the planning of their PMB, the prime converts the sub's planning package to a control account/work package and sets the BAC to the sub's BAC and places the sub's MR into the Prime's MR (segregating it in the budget log so the prime knows not to use it). Any difference between the sub's CBB and the original estimate can be reconciled with the prime's MR when the contract is awarded. From this point forward, everything is a simple roll-up. The sub should submit a budget log monthly along with the IPMR reports so that adjustments to the sub's MR can be reflected in the prime's reporting.
