

CSDR Working Group - 2018 Task Plan and Status

Products / Initiatives:

- <u>Establish communication</u> between NDIA-IPMD and CAPE/CADE/DCARC
 - Keep NDIA IPMD current on the changing environment and reporting requirements from CAPE and CADE
 - Provide industry comments on draft DIDs, etc.
 - CADE supporting our working group meetings
- Assess the need for any additional IPMD documents regarding CAPE

Tasks and Due Dates:

- Continue to coordinate the latest copies of the FlexFile, 1921-T, 1921-Q, and 1921-M/R DIDs
- Coordinate the support of the new Draft
 CBOM DID

Concerns and/or Collaboration:

- Challenge to engage industry Engineering and Maintenance organizations to identify comments to the 1921-T, 1921-Q and 1921-M/R DIDs
- Encourage software venders to generate the JSON files for the FlexFile DID

Discussions from Working Group 2 May 2018

- FlexFile Status:
 - "Straw man" FlexFile DID posted to CADE website (dated 15 Nov 2015)
 - Note: Current draft DEI and FFS documents are available
 - Currently have <u>10</u>? volunteer to pilot the FlexFile DID on current contracts
 - Hope to have a total of 25-36 pilots for 2018
 - A few one-on-one Industry/CADE meetings already taken place
 - Pilots are using Excel or CVS files. DCARC "Creation" pilot tool converts file to JSON format for importing files to CADE Portal
 - Working towards a verifiable FlexFile upload to demonstrate the "Straw man" DID
 - Still in the walk phase.
 - Document what works or doesn't work from the pilots
 - Looking to eventually get the 80% solution
 - Based on results of the FlexFile Pilots the Nov 2017 DID and associated DEI and FFS documents will be updated
 - Industry will have to meet the requirements of this "Final" DID
 - Two software Vendors participating in the CSDR Working Group. Both are working toward providing a FlexFile solution



Discussions from Working Group - 2 May 2018

- DODM 5000.04-M-1:
 - CAPE has updated the CSDR Manual
 - Documents when CSDRs should be invoked or applied.
- MIL-STD-881D (8 April 2018):
 - The MIL-STD-881D has been updated; industry must carefully review PARCA's changes
 - The CADE CSDR Plan templates will be updated on the CADE public site to include the changes made to the MIL-STD-881D Appendices.
 - Industry is recommending that an implementation memo should be released to say it is not retroactive and the affectivity date going forward.
- Found out that CAPE has been sending CSDR delivery status to the buying commands
 - Shows the: 1) Finalized submissions for current yr; 2) Overdue Submissions; 3)
 Upcoming submissions, and 4) History of submissions.





Discussions from Working Group 2 May 2018

- The IPMD Working Group does want to stay engaged and be the conduit with CADE regarding the new /proposed DIDs also under consideration.
 - 1921-Technical Data DID (Nov 2017)
 - It is moving forward but is focused on determining fewer but "key" technical attributes
 - 1921-Quanity Data DID (Nov 2017) Moving forward
 - 1921-Maintenaince & Repair DID (Nov 2017) On hold
 - Consolidated Bill Of Material DID (Draft DID Jan 2018) On hold
 - 8 Feb 2018, CADE <u>published</u> a second option for the Contractor Business Data Report (Draft 1921-3 DID)
- Working Group will be informed of all Focus Group meetings and Training hosted by CADE this year
 - Aviation Cost IPT held a meeting in late April
 - CSDR Focus Group meeting planned for <u>27-28 June</u> at <u>LMCO</u> in <u>Crystal City</u>
 - CSDR Training May 31st at Ft Belvoir
