

Step 1 Submit your idea to the crowd



Step 2 Contribute and refine

Current ideas on the FirstBuild "co-create" page:

- · A direct-exchange geothermal air conditioning system
- · Sensor that adjusts your burner to keep pots from boiling over



Step 3 Make and produce



Step 4 Sell the product



- Ideas are refined by the FirstBuild community.
- · Voting determines which ideas go on to become products.
- FirstBuild provides tools and resources to build a prototype.
- Rapid and advanced manufacturing techniques produce products quickly, giving customers the ability to provide quick feedback and influence the design.
- FirstBuild helps sell and promote the products through a dedicated, marketplace web site.






