





Intel Received

- Legacy HMMWVs are being divested by the services.
- JLTV Total fielded 5,859
- JLTV MA average for 12 months is 93.40% for total orders of 79,554.
- Total of 6,489 NSNs for JLTV 1,248 unique to J8A. Majority are AAC Z and AAC J (non-stocked)
