Differences Between NMLC and PDAC



• Tenure of leadership linked to Leadership Conferences

- Focus on topics relevant to member leaders
- NMLC aligned with Senior VP for Strategy and Policy
 - Makes NMLC a policy advising body as well as forum for chapter and division collaboration
- Quarterly online meetings with anytime collaboration through Higher Logic
 - Should provide more interaction without formal meetings

 - Chapter Collaboration on Division Events
- NMLC Process/Issue Identified 2 Platform for easy collaboration/interaction
 - NDIA Outcomes
 - Higher Logic in development with rollout soon
- NMLC Process/Issue Identified 3 Solid data, accurate Database of Membership, their chapter and division affiliations
 - NDIA Outcomes
 - Regular updates of Chapter rosters to Chapter membership chairs
 - Better access to Chapter and Division leadership via Higher Logic

Focus Topic: Relevance



- NMLC Process/Issue Identified 1 Sync divisions and chapters to find strengths and gaps
 - NDIA Outcomes:
 - Standardizing Business Operations
 - Co-locating and combining Divisions PSA and SLAAD, Robotics and Armaments
- NMLC Process/Issue Identified 2 Analysis of Strategic Priorities and alignment for Thought Leadership
 - NDIA Outcomes:
 - Mapping engagements to NDIA Strategic Roadmap (in development)
- NMLC Process/Issue Identified 3 Need for Advisor roles across Chapters/Divisions
 - NDIA Outcomes:
 - Moving towards Advisory Council model composed of SMEs who can be resources for Divisions and Chapters
 - Provides expertise and support to divisions and chapters on cross-cutting issues

Focus Topic: Advisory Councils (formerly COIs)

 - NDIA Outcomes

 - Moving towards model of Advisory Councils for cross-cutting issues
- NMLC Process/Issue Identified 2 ACs should reside on Higher Logic collaboration platform
 - NDIA Outcomes
 - Multiple Advisory Councils on collaboration platform make for easy sharing of lessons learned
