

All service munitions supervisors of headquarters, munitions plants, depots, laboratories, and proving grounds are asked to seriously consider the contributions of their best qualified subordinates for this prestigious award.

- Be an individual of any grade or position within the United States Fuze Community.
- Receive this recognition for notable achievements made throughout one's career and lifetime.
- Have had a positive, lasting impact on the advancement of fuzing.
- Be available to receive the award at the 63rd Annual Fuze Conference in May 11 - 13, 2020.
