The National Defense Industrial Association's Systems Engineering Excellence Awards were established in 2003 to honor the memory of Lt Gen Thomas R. Ferguson, Jr., USAF, whose leadership embodied the highest ideals in the development and deployment of defense systems.

Previous recipients include Ms. Kristen Baldwin, the Office of the Secretary of Defense, and the Computational Research and Engineering Acquisition Tools and Environments (CREATE) program team.
