# NDIA HOW TO: Use GoToWebinar as an attendee

# PRE-WEBINAR CONFIRMATION EMAIL

Upon registration, GoToWebinar will send you an automated confirmation email like the one to the right, which will contain your unique webinar access link, a webinar access password (if utilized), and call-in information. Through the automated confirmation email, you can also add the webinar to your preferred calendar and check your system requirements to ensure proper access to the webinar.

#### Add to Celendar

1. Click the link to join the webinar at the specified time and date:



## CONDENSED CONTROL DOCK

To the left is an example of your condensed control dock. Select the orange arrow to see more about your audio and the questions box feature.



## MAIN CONTROL DOCK

Here is your main control dock. You can see if you are muted or unmuted. Attendees are muted unless unmuted by an organizer. You can also see where your audio is coming from and who is speaking.
